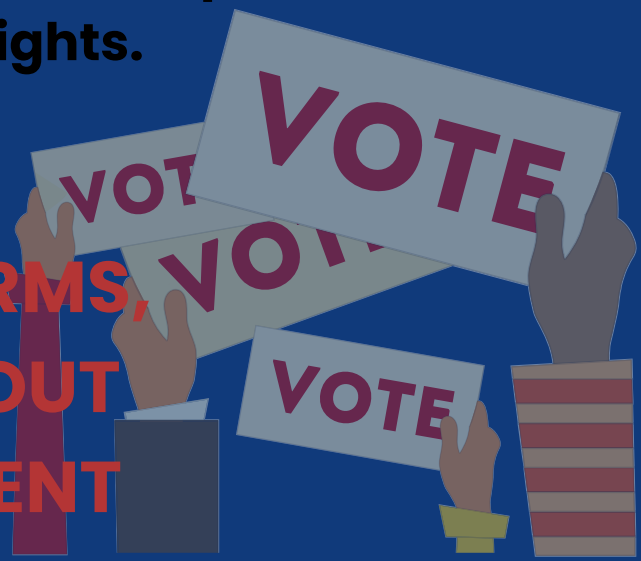


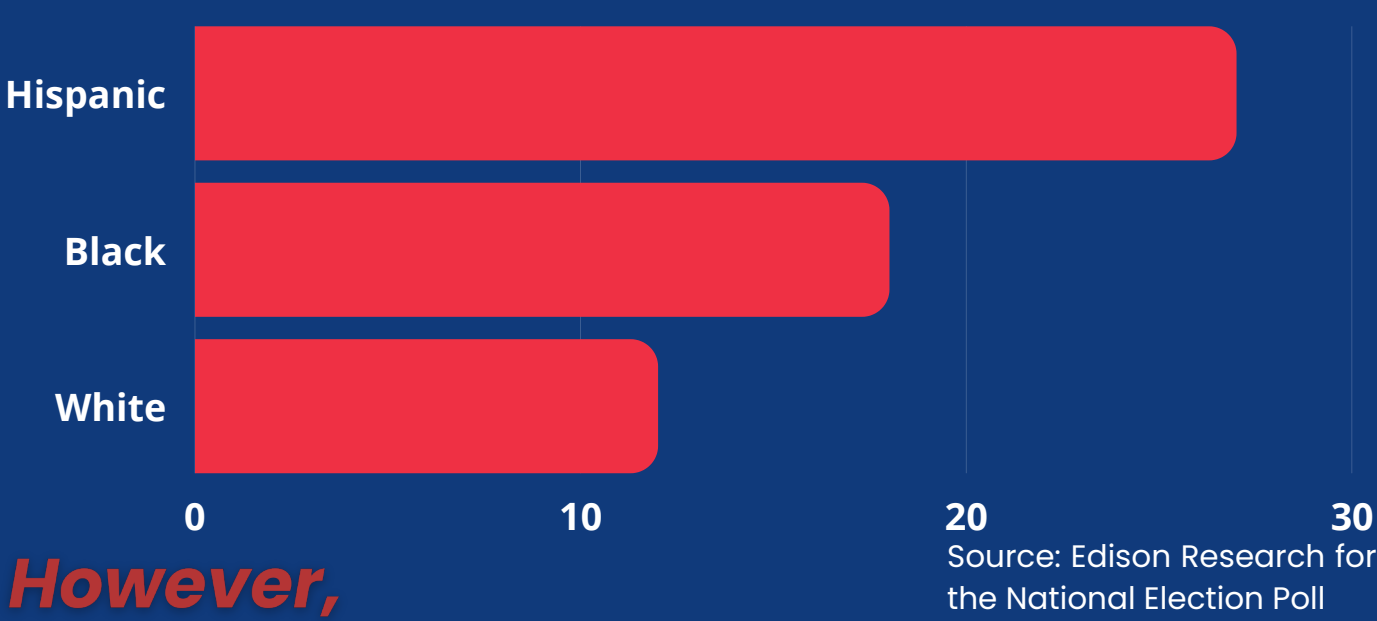
LATINX YOUTH: YOUR VOTE IS YOUR VOICE!!

(2018, by percentage of eligible voters in that category)

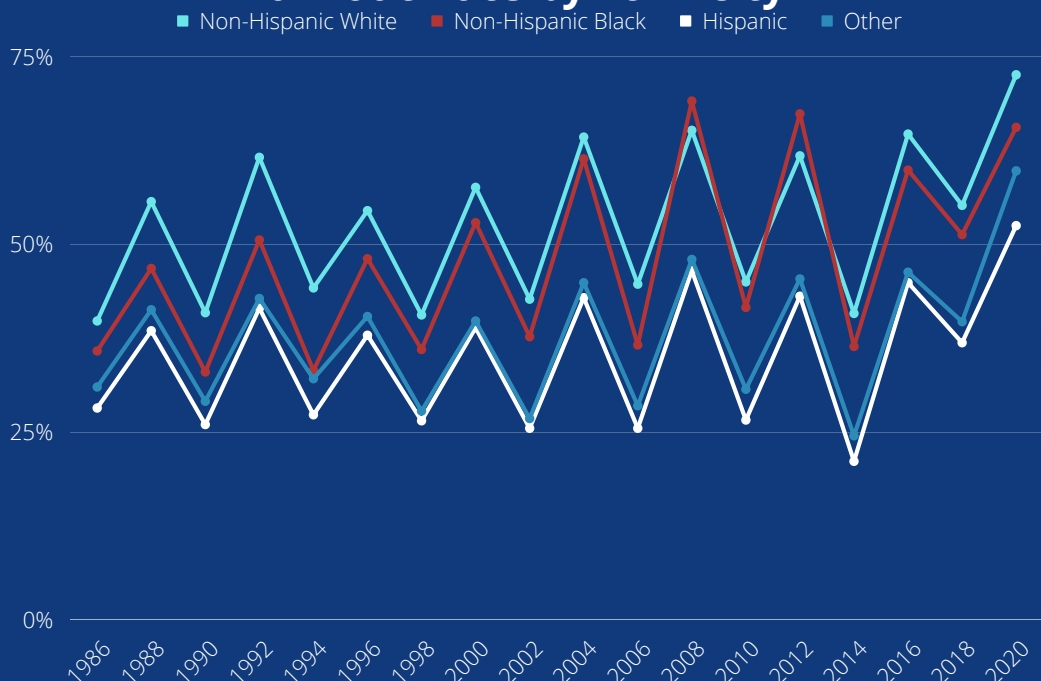


However,

12 million Latinos are eligible to vote but have not yet registered.

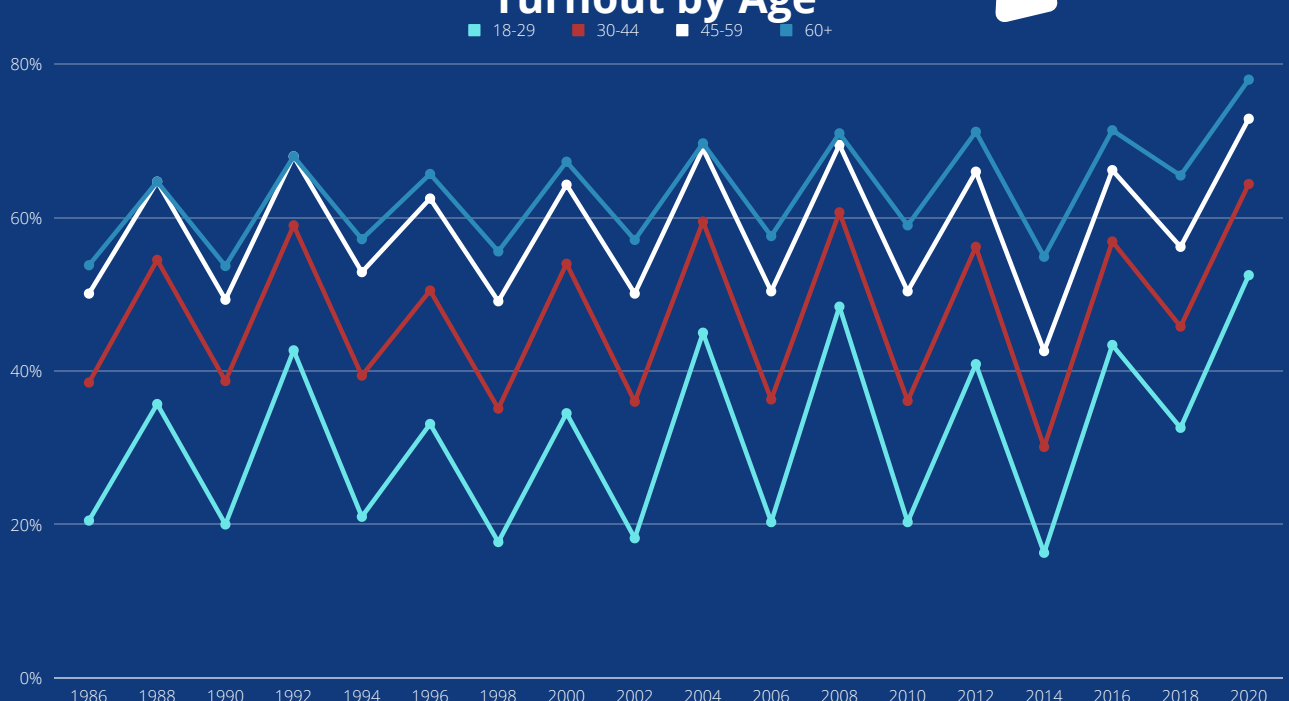

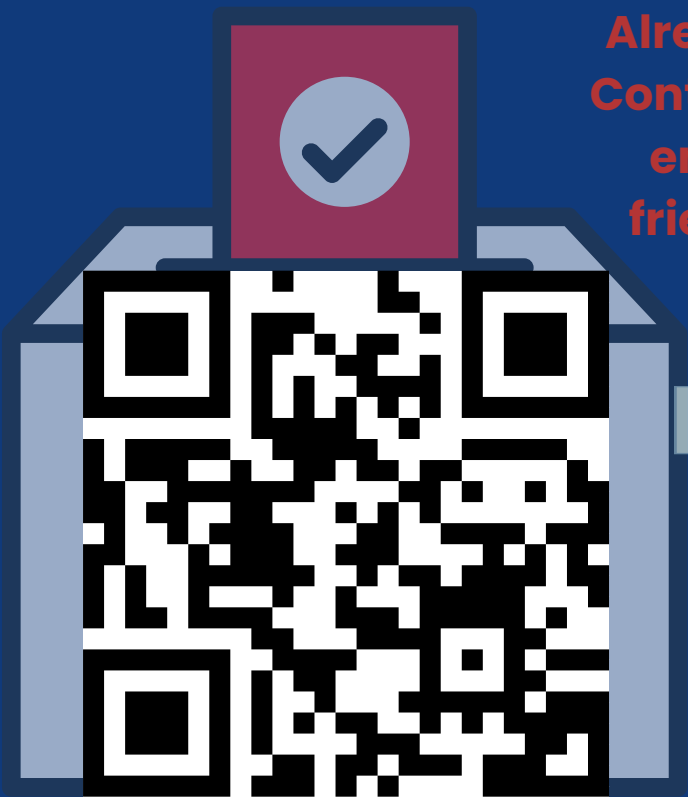
Citizen Voting-Age Population Turnout by Age
