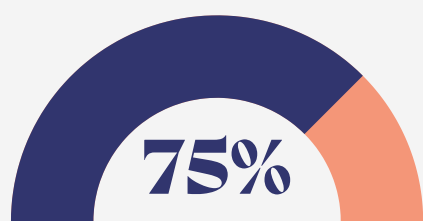
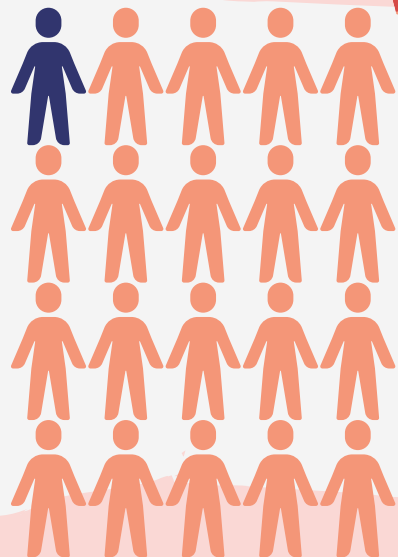


# BUILD BACK BETTER Immigration

## HOW MANY?

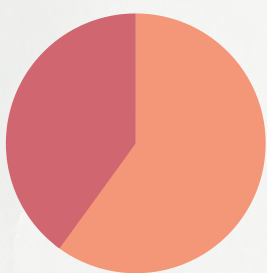
1 in 20 U.S. Residents live with a person who will be positively impacted by the Immigration provision in Build Back Better

75% of voters are likely to support Build Back Better's immigration provision

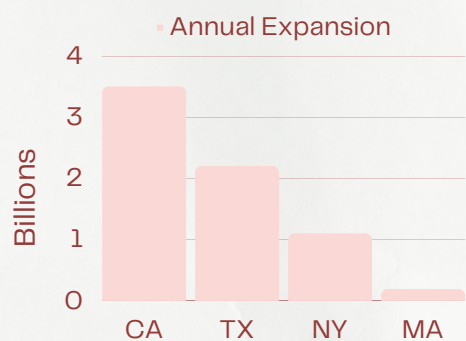

### A Bipartisan Choice

60% of Republicans and 80% of Independent voters support the Immigration reform in BBB



Build Back Better will add \$17 billion annually to the economy (excluding taxes). CA will add \$3.5B, TX \$2.2B, NY \$1.1B, and MA \$191 million of the 17B.

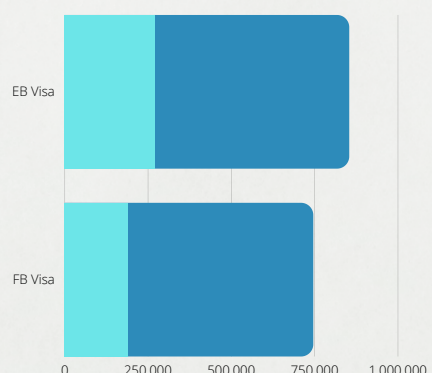
## How Will It Help?

Build Back Better will protect millions of undocumented citizens from deportation and allow access to employment and health care.

## WILL IT HURT AMERICA?

The immigration provision in Build Back Better will allow an increase of \$10 billion in taxes.

## What Will Happen?



188,905 of 556,119 "lost" family-based visas and 270,661 of 582,275 employment-based visas will be recaptured, allowing more opportunities for citizenship

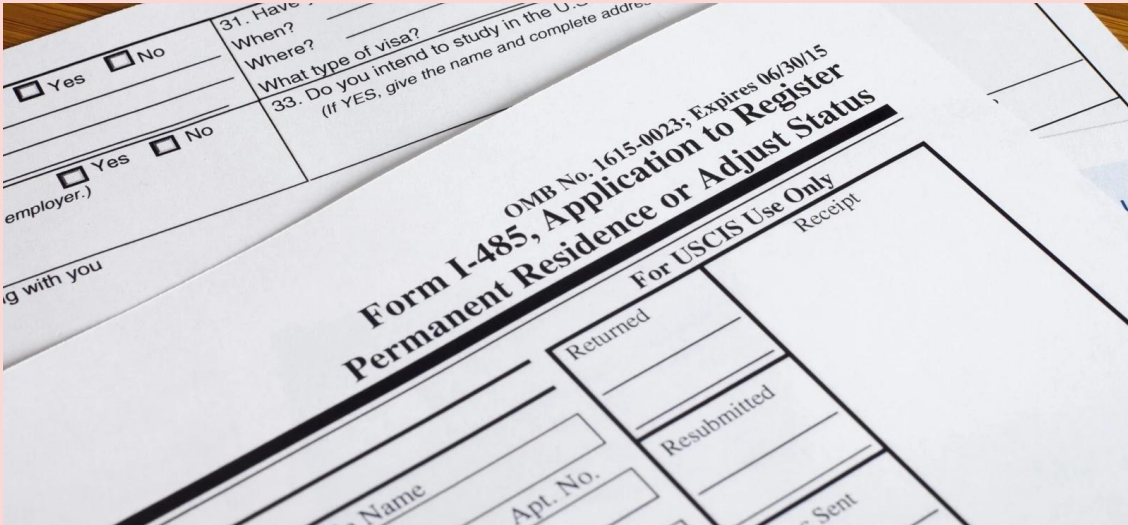

7.1 million undocumented immigrants will be able to apply for "parole". 91% of applicants (6.5M) will be granted parole.

July 2023 → September 2031

Parole would last 8.5 years if applications came in January 2022. Undocumented immigrants would be able to apply for State licenses and be granted work authorization



Early Filing of and Adjustment of Status Application will reduce backlogged visa applications by allowing non-citizens to pay a fee for early filing



\$3 Billion in New Fees

Early filing applicants will pay \$1500 for themselves and an additional \$250 for each spouse and underage child, adding \$3 billion to the economy
