


GROUP IDENTITY IN AMERICA



DEFINITION



Politics in which groups of people having a particular racial, religious, ethnic, social, or cultural identity tend to promote their own specific interests or concerns without regard to the interests or concerns of any larger political group



ORIGINS

The term was coined by Barbara Smith and other activists in 1977



CIVIL RIGHTS

The political and social unrest of the 1960's American South, such as sit-ins and lynching laid the foundation for the mass formation of group identity in America.



RELIGIOUS AFFILIATIONS

Muslims, particularly those in America, experience high levels of Islamophobia and much of this can be attributed to the 9/11 attacks. As a result, Muslim communities across America have come together to bond over their troubles.


INTERSECTIONALITY

Intersectionality refers to the study of overlapping discriminations



GROUP CONSCIOUSNESS

Group consciousness in political science refers to the phenomenon in which members within a social identity group become aware of how their group identification impacts their position in society, and therefore come together to pursue collective action to advocate for their shared interests.



SOCIAL IDENTITY THEORY

Social Identity Theory (SIT), a social psychological theory developed by Henri Tajfel and John Turner, posits that individuals derive a significant part of their identity, their "social identity," from their membership in social groups
