- <u>Notify your LRA</u> of the planned trip. If you plan to charge travel expenses to a grant, they will confirm that travel is allowable per the grant award terms, and sufficient funds are available.
- Submit the <u>Travel Justification Form</u> to <u>Dental.Finance@elist.tufts.edu</u>
 - If your trip does not receive prior approval must be received, <u>you may be held personally responsible</u> for any travel expenses
- Use a <u>University-authorized travel agent</u> when able to
- See the <u>Tufts Travel Policy</u> for non-reimbursable expenses, such as first/business class
- Submit a travel report with all receipts within 30-days of completing the travel

Federal Updates

The University and School leadership meet regularly to discuss ongoing impacts of the Presidential Executive orders related to federal funding.

What we know right now regarding federal research activities:

- 1. Study sections are being reactivated
- 2. NOAs (Notice of Awards) are being received
- 3. All drawdowns on accounts are occurring at a cadence that is appropriate for the agency
- 4. Burn-rate on grants should be consistent with time period before this uncertainty began and in alignment with grant activities (no unusual spending should occur)
- 5. Continue to check federal agency funding opportunities to ensure programs are open/available to receiving applications
- 6. NIH has proposed a cap on indirect cost rates at 15% for all Universities. We are assessing what this will mean moving forward. The notice is NOT-OD-25-068: Supplemental Guidance to the 2024 NIH Grants Policy Statement: Indirect Cost Rates.
- Any award-specific questions should be directed to OVPR pre-award- PIs should not directly contact sponsors/program directors at this time.
- The university will continue to hold Federal Actions Town Halls to provide updates to the community. The Office of the Provost has compiled a list of resources that will continue to be updated as the situation develops.
