Our Context

- Somaliland is an independent but unrecognized country in the Horn of Africa
- Peaceful transfers of power in democratically elected governments since 1991
- Abaarso School is a 7-12th grade coed boarding school serving local Somali students



Our Commitment

- Teach about 20 hours per week in the classroom with an additional 30-50 hours per week of work outside of class
- Classroom teaching, advisory groups, office hours, clubs, sports, administrative duties
- Monthly stipend, round-trip airfare, room & board, emergency health insurance



Our Results

- First students in Somaliland in 30 years to matriculate to US universities including Harvard, Yale, MIT, Brown, Columbia, Cornell
- Covered by 60 Minutes with Anderson Cooper, NY Times, CNN, MSNBC, and BBC
- Featured at the Clinton Global Initiative 2022
- Funded in part by USAID
