Our synagogue school meets on Sunday, 9:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and Wednesday, 3:30 - 5:30 p.m. Current teacher openings are for 1 day per week on Wednesday afternoon – we need a Kitah Gimmel (Gr. 3) and Kitah Hey/Vav (Gr. 5 & 6 combined) teacher.

Curriculum subjects include: Bible studies, Hebrew, History, Holidays, Israel, Mitzvot (obligations) and Parashat Hashavua (Torah portion of the week).

Applicants should have experience teaching or working with children, a strong Jewish background, and be willing to collaborate on lesson planning (follow a written curriculum, submit a lesson plan and make edits to it prior to class). Temple Shalom is a Conservative Movement affiliated synagogue. We offer teacher support, generous compensation, a relaxed setting and small student groups.
