VISA AND TEMPORAL RESIDENCE PROCEDURE Getting Upon receiving a completed application form & copy of the passport **Russian visa** from the applicant MGIMO sends a request to the Department of Consulate Service of Foreign Ministry of Russia in Moscow (not earlier

than 45 days prior to student's arrival). The Department sends an official invitation telex directly to the Russian Consulate in the student's home country. The Reference Number of this telex is forwarded to the student. The Reference Number is the only condition for obtaining a single entry student visa for 90 days. This type of visa is extended upon student's arrival at MGIMO 45 days before the visa expires. Letter of Invitation or Letter of Acceptance is not required! All international citizens arriving to Russia must be registered by the **Temporal** registration Federal Migration Department within 7 working days. The registration should be renewed whenever person temporally

leaves Russia and returns back. The penalty for violation the immigration regulations is deportation.
