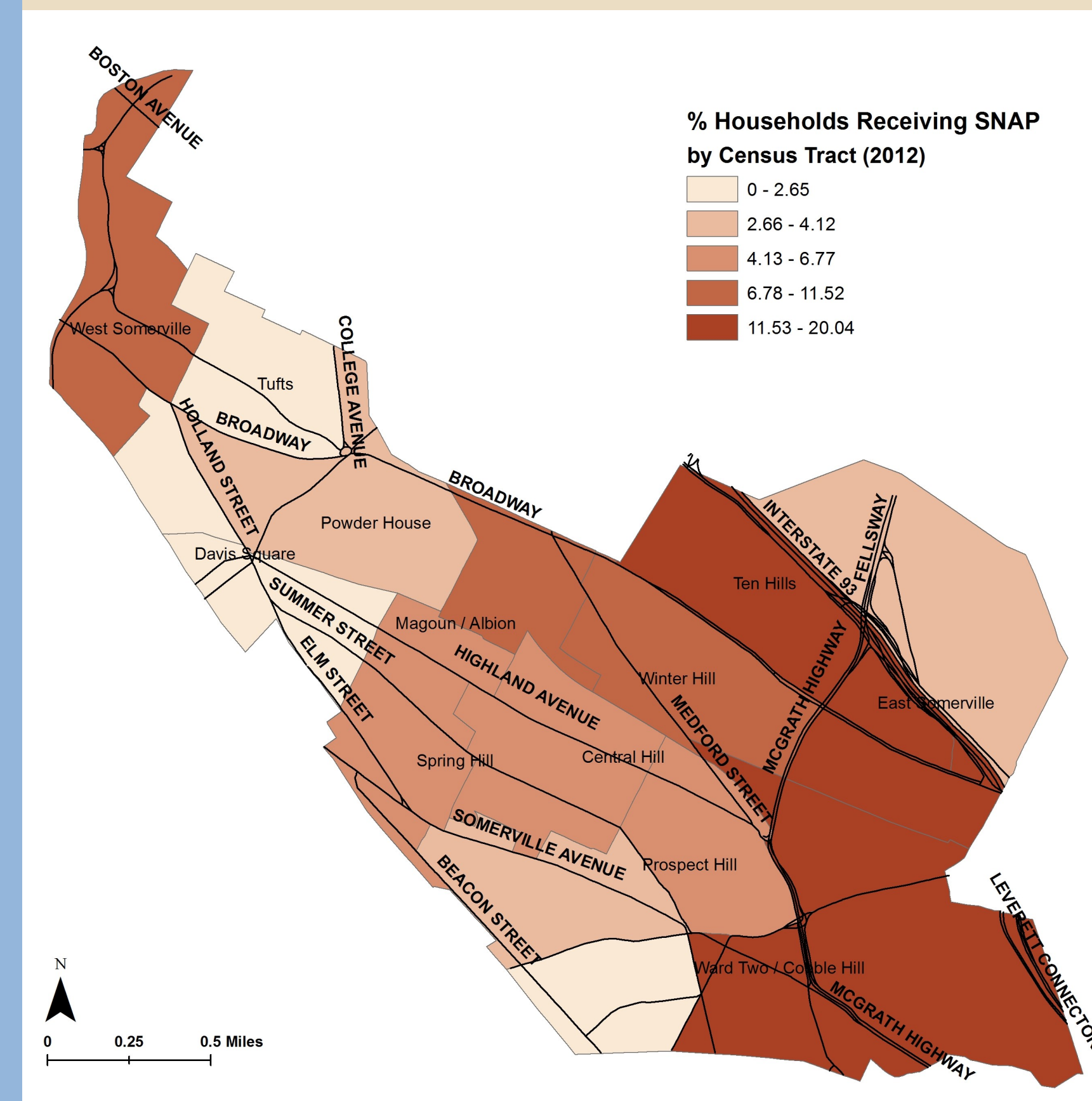

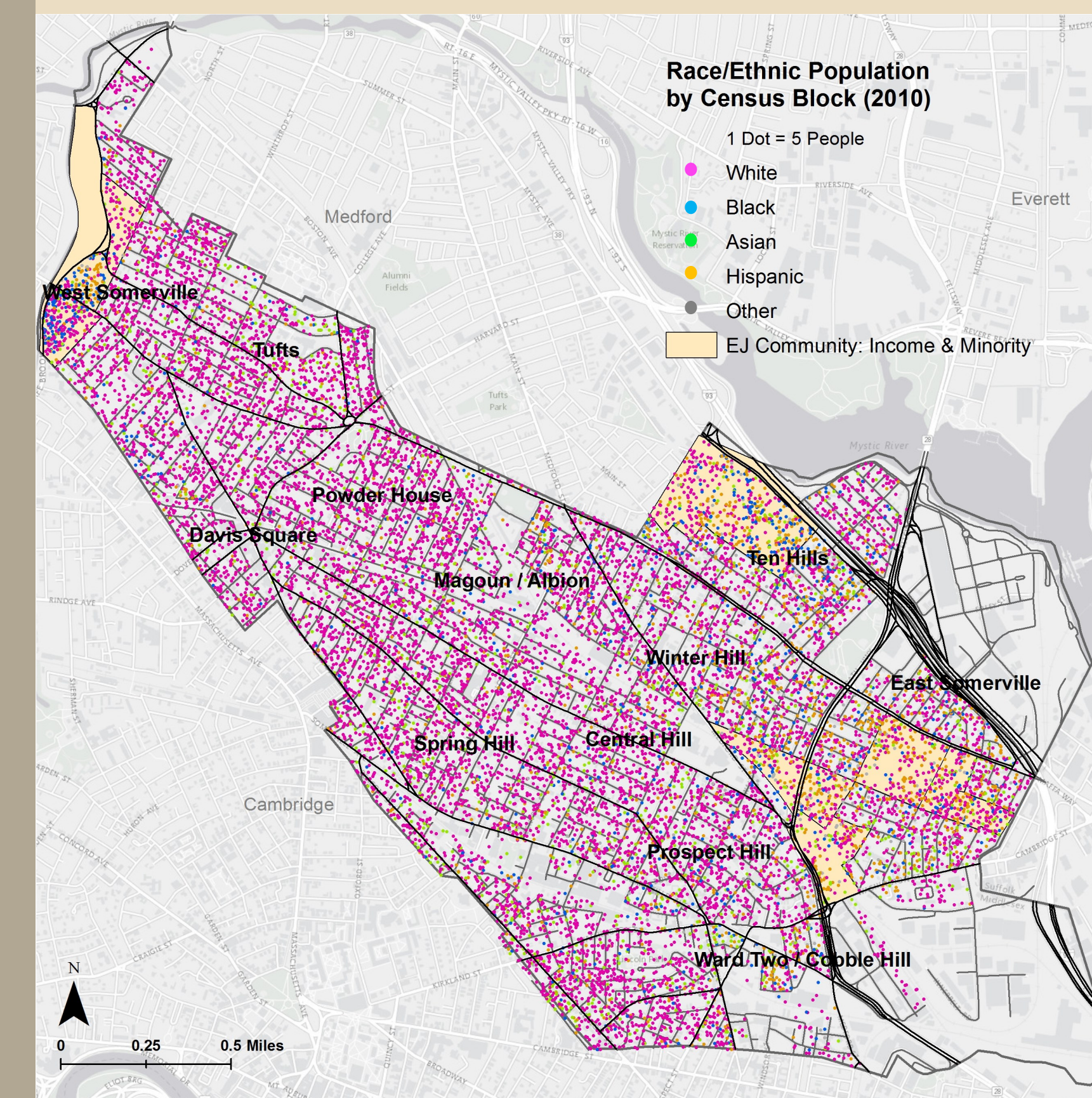
Housing Composition—Family Households



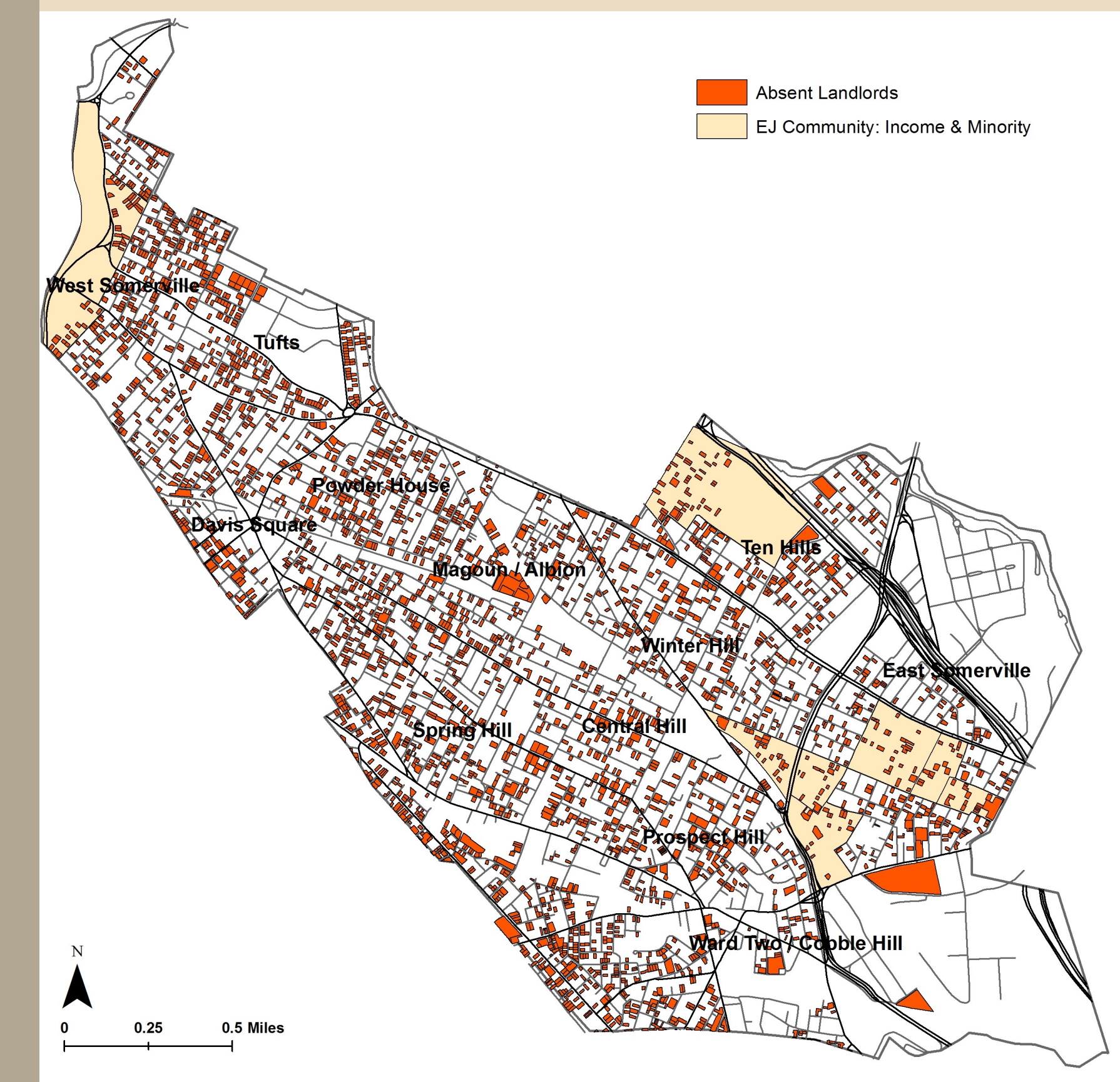
Housing Tenure—Renters
