



Tufts Digital Library deposit license instructions

1. In Adobe, click "Fill and Sign" in the right toolbar, or find it under the Tools menu at the top
2. Click the blue "Fill and Sign" button
3. On the last page, fill out the Describe the materials... box
4. To sign your name:
 - a. click into the signature box
 - b. click the Sign button at the top of the screen under the menu bar
 - c. click Add Signature
 - d. click the Draw button at the top of the box
 - e. use your mouse to sign your name
 - f. hit Apply. You'll now have a signature that you can drag into the box
5. Fill in the rest of the info at the bottom of this page
6. Save the document and return it
