
President (2)

- Run general body meetings and officer meetings
 - Coordinate speakers or presentations
- Oversee and support all major projects and officer responsibilities; provide support and feedback to officers in their duties
- Communicate with faculty SOTA advisor (Meredith!)
- Leading SOTA in department and university-wide activities
- Informing department of upcoming meetings and events via accessible platforms
 - WordPress blog, email
- Complete annual GSC paperwork, maintain constitution

Secretary (1)

- Keeps accurate minutes of officer and general body meetings
- Updates social media pages updated with meetings, events, resources and general information
 - Facebook, Instagram, Twitter

Treasurer (2)

- Sets yearly budget in collaboration with all officer positions
 - Applies for GSC funds, allocates received funds, maintains electronic and written records of all incomes and expenses
- Communicates finances to all members at general body meetings
- Coordinates ordering and picking up food for monthly SOTA meetings
 - In-person meetings!
- Maintains snack bar in SOTA lounge



Community Service Chair (1)

- Organizes volunteering for Tufts Kids Day (Spring) and Community Day (Fall)
 - Maintains materials for these events- sensory car wash
 - Cancelled this year due to COVID
- Coordinates participation in additional volunteer events that arise throughout the year
- Collaborates with AOTA/MAOT representative to facilitate Hill Day
- Monitors social media for relevant volunteer opportunities to advertise to SOTA



Fundraising Chair (1)

- Organizes and communicates all fundraising efforts, including yearly swag orders in the fall
- Collaborates with treasurer to select and reach fundraising goals
- Researches and establishes relationship with fundraising community partners
 - Boston Brakers!
- Works with Community Service Chair to coordinate annual fundraising event
 - ADPA Optimism Walk in May, Cere-bration Walk in September

Social Activities Chair (2)

- Ensures events are advertised to whole GSAS student body if GSAS funds are used
- Coordinates funds allocation with treasurer

- Helps execute other AOTA events throughout the year such Hill Day




