# Literacy and the Arts

One-on-One Tutoring in the Context of an *Extraordinarily Fun* Summer Day.



**Session 1 - Science Week:** Do your kids love to play with worms and slugs? Take flowers apart to see what's inside? Explore the unseen by peering through a microscope? Build rockets? During this science week, writing will revolve around the science project of your child's choice. This is *not* a "one size fits all" experience. Let us know in advance what your child would like to do – and we'll have the supplies by the first day of camp. Every morning, your child will work with his or her own tutor on an individualized project. The rest of the day? A lot of fun with outdoor sports, games, art projects and new friends of all ages.



**Literacy and the Arts:** Every morning, your child will work with his or her tutor on writing and targeted academic skills. Creative writing is our centerpiece during this two-week session. We use art, literature and drama to inspire children to express themselves on paper. We will also work with you to develop an individualized tutoring agenda. Our talented, college-age tutors help children read more fluently, learn to keyboard, and memorize times tables. Each child's plan depends on his or her particular needs.



The rest of day is simply fun. An energetic crew of Tufts athletes, scientists, drama leaders and artists are on hand to play with your children. They engage the children in sports on the Tufts fields, and entertain them with hilarious drama games. We give children a wide range of choices, so our summer afternoons feel like summer. What better way to spend the not so lazy days of summer?
