Social Policy

ADMISSION

- **ID Required:** All students must have valid Tufts Student ID. All guests must have valid government issued photo ID.
- **Security Screenings:** All concertgoers will be subject to security screening, including metal detectors. Staff and security reserve the right to inspect and/or refuse the admittance of any person or item.
- **Student Entrance:** Enter through the Academic Quad, between Ballou Hall and the Chapel. Gates close promptly at 3:00pm.
- **Guest Entrance:** Enter through the Academic Quad, between Ballou Hall and Barnum Hall.
- **Valid Tickets:** Tickets will be scanned at the entrance, and names on the ticket AND scanner MUST match the name on your Tufts Student ID. Tickets are non-transferrable.
- **There is no re-entry into the show. No exceptions.**
- All guests **must be 18** years of age or older.

NO BAGS

- **Bags, including wallet-sized wristlets and fanny packs, will not be permitted into the venue. No exceptions.**
- Blankets are permitted. Be prepared to display the contents of all blankets.
- Confiscated items will be disposed of at the discretion of Spring Fling staff.
- TUSC and Tufts University are not responsible for items left unattended.

FOOD & BEVERAGES

- **No outside food or beverages (including ice) will be permitted into the venue. No exceptions.**
- Water and pizza will be provided free of charge during the show.
- If you have a food allergy, you may contact the Office for Campus Life at ocl@tufts.edu to make arrangements.

BEHAVIOR

- **All Tufts University policies and standards of behavior will be strictly enforced.**
- **Alcohol:** Visibly intoxicated students will not be admitted into the event. This is a substance free event.
- Students found to be disruptive or in violation of any laws or University policies will be immediately removed and subject to disciplinary action.
- All Tufts students, alumni, faculty or staff members are responsible for their guest(s) and will be held accountable for their actions.
- Please dispose of any trash in the proper receptacles located throughout the venue.
