


Precincts

Most states don't store shapefiles of their precinct boundaries





But what about Census VTDs?





The Census releases something called voting tabulation districts for *most* states once every 10 years. In practice, it's not clear that states use them for election administration, especially 9 years out from the last census.


Census Geographic Hierarchy




Ohio
