


Chicago City Council

- Large/Inefficient


Possible reform proposals:

- Move to ranked choice voting





Current 50 Ward Plan


At-Large Voting













Ensemble Analysis


Ensembles of 100,000 plans generated using a recombination Markov chain:

- **50**×**1** ensemble 50 singlemember districts built from precincts
- **10**×**m** ensemble 10 multimember districts built from precincts
- 10×m CA ensemble 10 multimember districts built from community areas
